If you have been listening to Governor Walz's press conferences it appears that schools may not be opening after spring break. However, please wait for any further announcements. If that is the case after our spring break week, our school is prepared. Yesterday as a staff we met to put together our long-range (distance) learning plan. We will be emailing and mailing out the plan to each household for Kindergarten – 8th grade.

Students are to have all necessary materials at home with them if/when we begin our distance learning. Students should have their chrome books, textbooks, Ipads, workbooks, notebooks, etc. for every one of their classes. Only one device per sibling group will be issued by the school and only if they do not have a computer, laptop, chrome book or Ipad at home already. We expect that siblings will be able to share the devices issued by the school.

If you need to pick up your child's materials please come next week between 7:00 am -3:30 pm. Please do not spend more time in the building than necessary. We are taking the matter of distancing very seriously for the safety of everyone. Please do not bring your child into the school. Only parents will have access to pick their child's things up. Thank you for understanding.

Students will clear out their lockers and desks today. For students not in attendance, belongings will be put in bags and stored. Parents are welcome to pick them up next week. Wendy and I will be in the building between the hours of 7:00 am – 3:30 pm.

Our school distance plan will require students and parents to log in and connect with their child's teacher for attendance purposes and to do all assigned work which will be graded.
